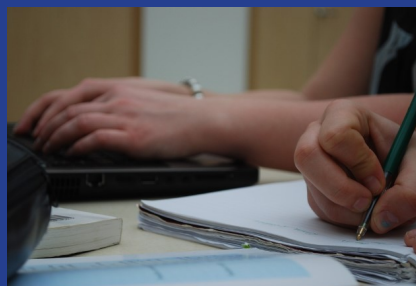
Funding Opportunities

HCF Large Grants(deadline: 23rd March 2018) - Grants of up to £5000 are available for groups helping to tackle identified need in the county, including those highlighted in [Hertfordshire Matters](#).

PCC Action Fund(deadline: 30th March 2018) - This fund will be open for four rounds this year for applications of up to £5,000 to support innovative local projects which aim to reduce crime and help make our communities safer.

#iwill grant(deadline: 9th April 2018) - iwill programme is open for applications (previously known as Youth Social Action Fund). Grants from £1,000 to £5,000 are available for great youth social action projects. Previously successful applicants are welcome to apply for repeat funding. There will be another deadline in September 2018.
