### Domestic Abuse Support

Grants from £10,000 to £50,000 are available for organisations who work with people from under-represented groups who may not be accessing traditional domestic abuse services. Hertfordshire Grassroots Grant Fund for Domestic Abuse Support builds on the successful launch of the Domestic Abuse Community Outreach Service in July 2023 and will help ensure all Hertfordshire residents have access to domestic abuse support services that are right for them. Specialist domestic abuse training will be available as part of the grant.
